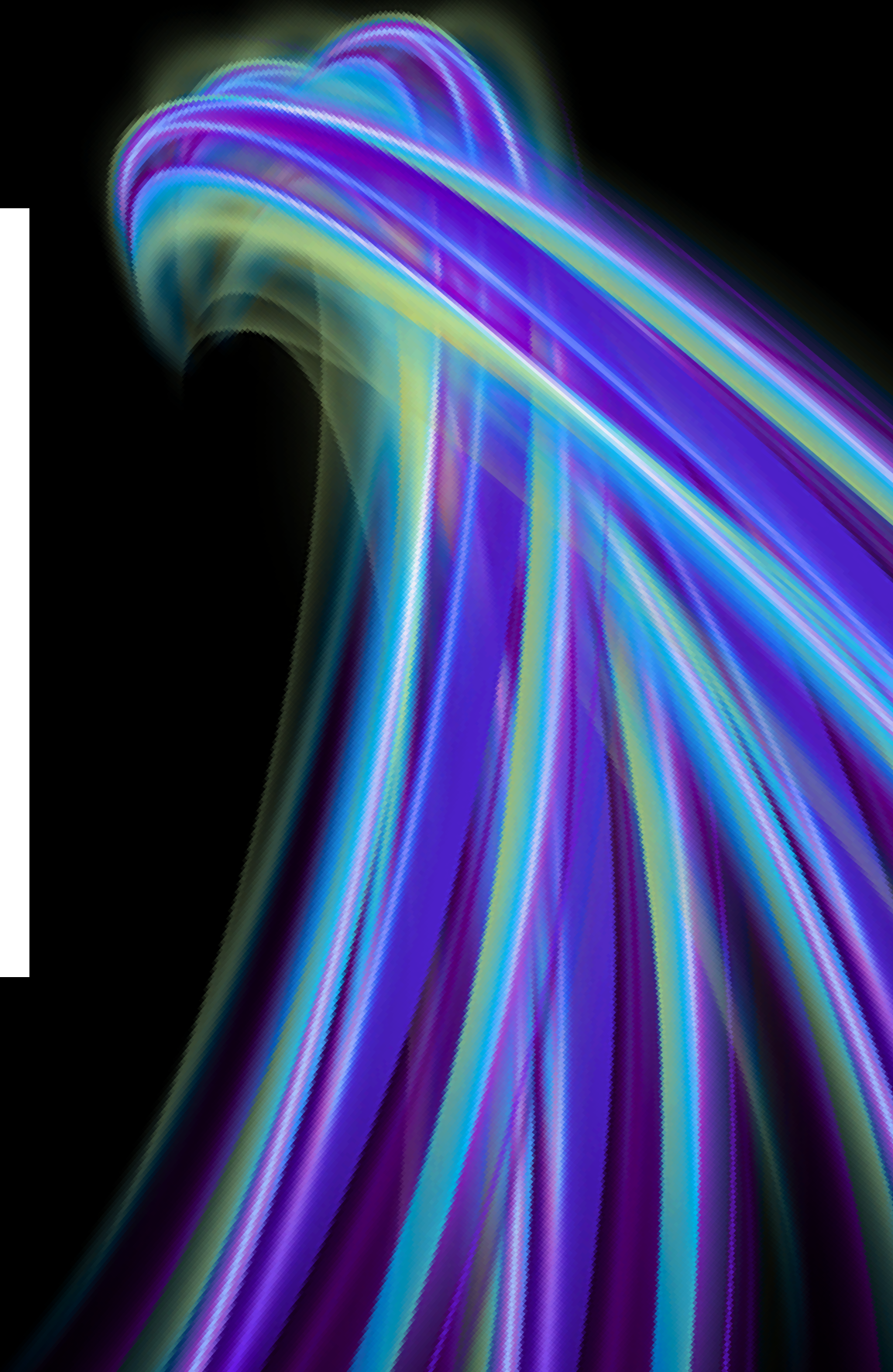

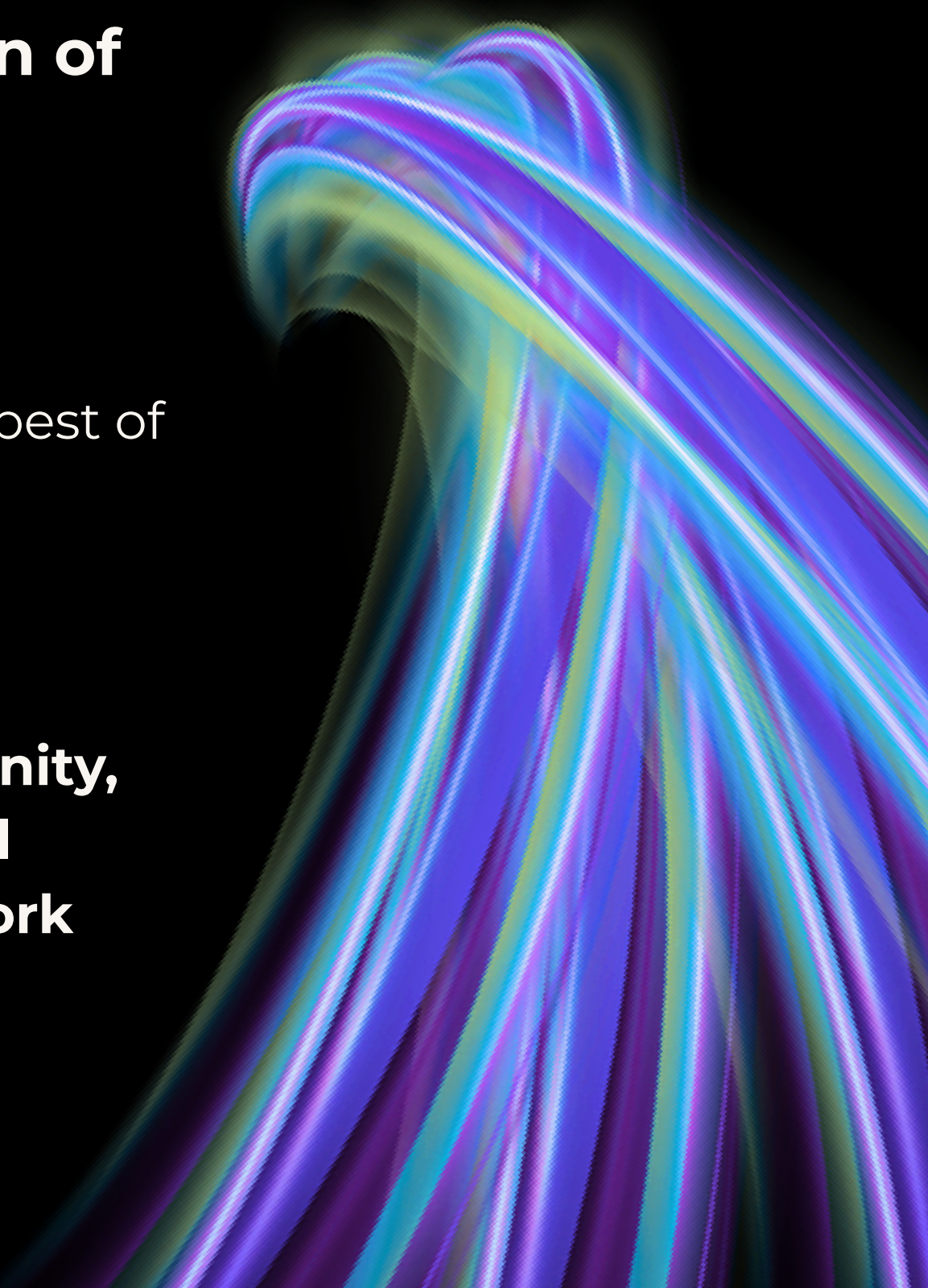


The BECBC Awards are recognised as an impactful celebration of business excellence across the Energy Coast and beyond.

BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

Any size business may enter the Business of the Year Award. This award will recognise a broad spectrum of business success criteria:

- describe your three biggest achievements since May 2025
- what challenges you have encountered and how you overcome these
- your vision for future success

This person could be the owner or an employee of the organisation. They must be able to demonstrate:

- outstanding business acumen
- excellent leadership skills
- remarkable growth in their business in the period from May 2025
- examples of how they deliver beyond the financial bottom line
- strong motivation and to have distinguished themselves in their area of expertise

RISING STAR

This award recognises an individual who is early in their career, regardless of age, who has made a substantial contribution to their employer and invested in their career. The criteria are:

- demonstrable career progress through promotion, role change or going the extra mile
- achievement of academic or technical qualifications
- ability to overcome barriers

- how has the organisation acknowledged and balanced out negative social value

PERFORMANCE CULTURE

This award category seeks to celebrate member organisations who actively take a 'whole system' approach to good organisational performance.
