Equality of opportunity

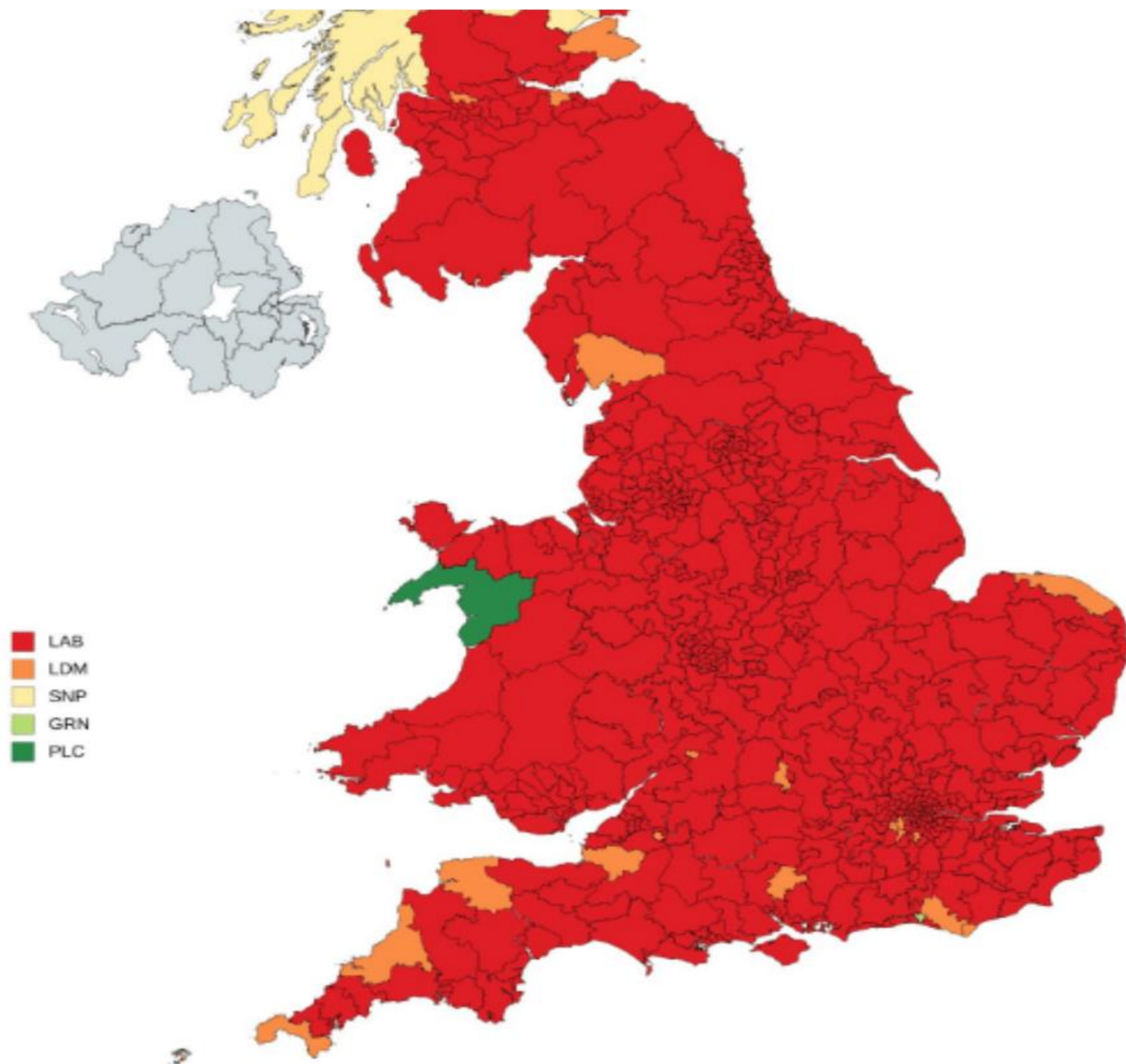
Unique

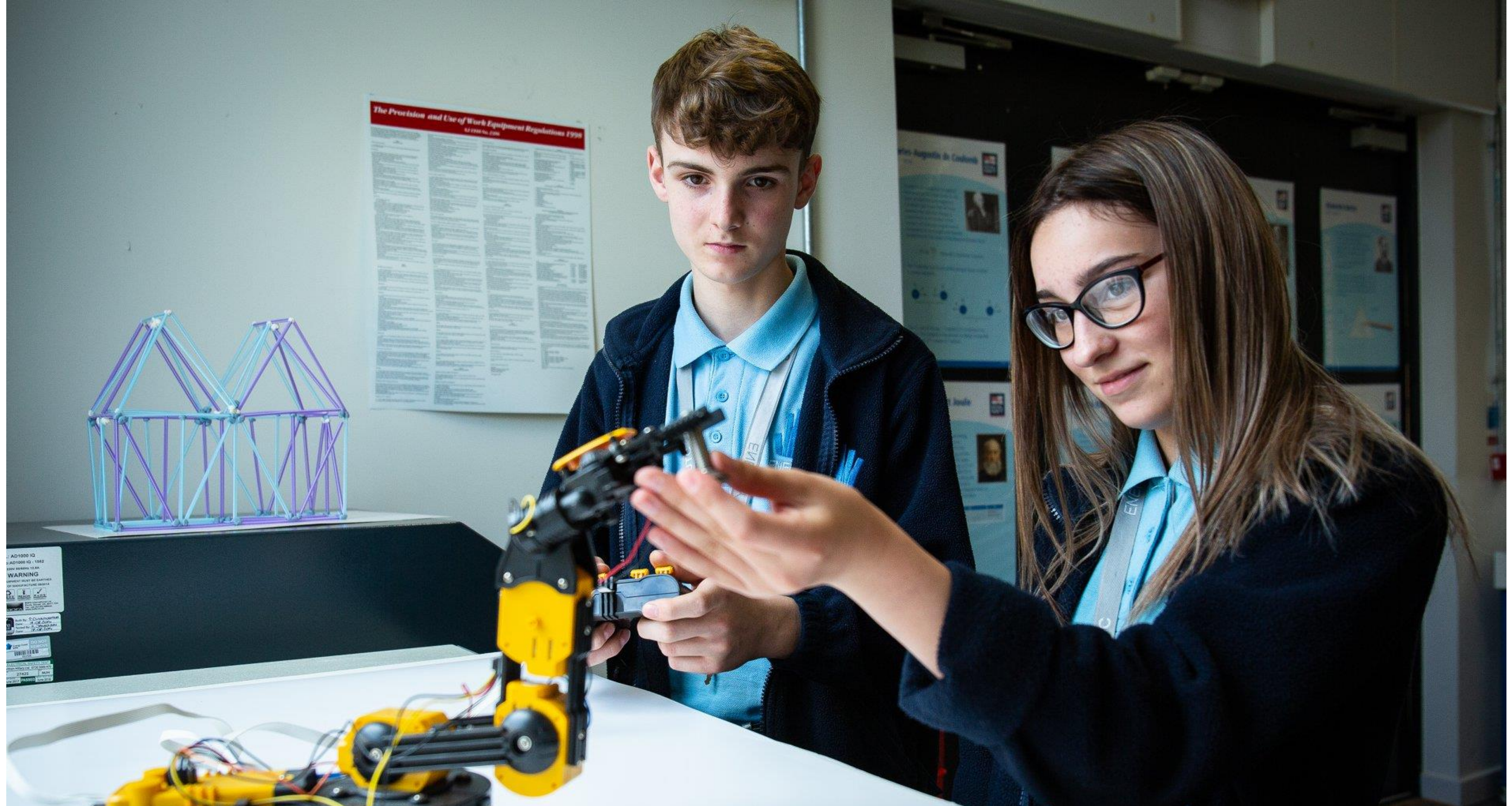
