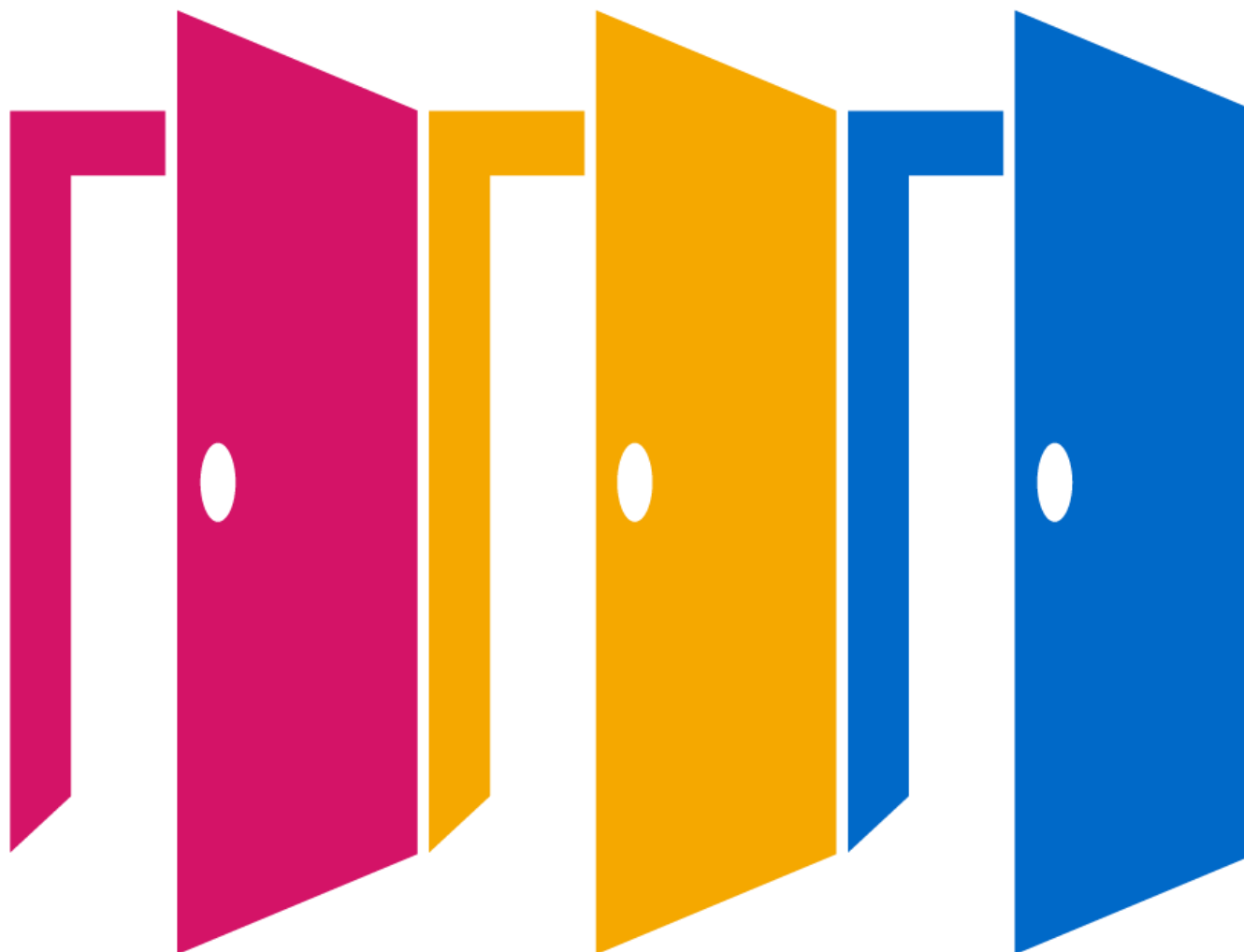

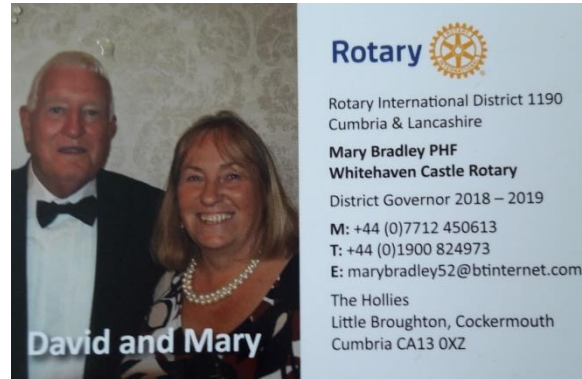
Social Corporate responsibility :-
