2019 Annual Report available on banner stand today – see how we use your generous donations to best effect.





In 2019, **26** BECBC member organisations supported the BECBC Social Value Delivery Group to the sum of **£50k** which funds the BSCP.

This enabled **130 companies**, **325 individual volunteers to carry out 526 visits into school, contributing 1315 voluntary hours**. This meant that **9300** students participated across all **15 secondary** schools across Copeland and Allerdale.

In a national report published by the Careers and Enterprise Company, students in the Cumbria area came top of the list when measuring the number of "encounters with employers" with **64.9**% of schools achieving the benchmark 5 encounters or more. The national average for this benchmark is **38.3**%.

This is a **fantastic achievement**, but I know we can do even better with your continued support.
